## 2. INTRODUCTION


Use as part of a complete garage storage system or as an individual storage unit. Four drawers fitted with ball bearing slides. Features adjustable feet for levelling on uneven floors. Supplied with worktop and a lock with two keys. Supplied flat-packed for ease of transportation and requires some simple self-assembly.






# 5. ASSEMBLY


5.1. Assemble small drawers as per fig.2.





5.2. Assemble large drawers as per fig.3.




- 5.3. Assemble base and side panels as per fig.4.
- 5.4. Attach top of cabinet as per fig.5.
- 5.5. Square the cabinet frame. Make sure the measurements from corner to corner are equal in distance before tightening the bolts.








- **5.7.** Attach the four legs to the base as per fig.6.
- **5.8.** Position the worktop in place and fix using screws provided.
- **5.9.** Ensure all screws are in place and have been tightened.





- 5.10. Position a drawer on a set of runners and push it carefully until it stops. If the operation is not smooth remove drawer and repeat.
- 5.11. Repeat for other drawers.
- **5.12.** If the drawer needs to be removed pull the drawer all the way out, then push the plastic release lever on the ball bearing slides one up and one down as shown. fig.7. Then pull the drawer completely out.
  - N.B. Maximum weight limit drawers:- 25Kg Maximum weight limit cabinet:- 150Kg
