

4. OPERATION

4.1. Locate tool to clutch spigot bearing and engage tapered section to clutch plate. Ensure a good fit but DO NOT force the alignment tool in such that it causes damage.

5. MAINTENANCE

- 5.1. Clean the tool after use with a soft clean cloth and lightly oil the surfaces to prevent surface corrosion.
- 5.2. Store the tool such that no physical damage can occur to any of its surfaces.
